

Setting up AutoCAD Civil 3D 2020 - National NRCS

Here are steps that NRCS CADD users need to take in order to setup their Autodesk Civil 3D 2020.

If you have a workspace that you have created and would like to use in Civil 3D 2020, please follow the directions for Saving and Importing Workspace prior to having 2020 installed.

1. **IT:** Installs the CADD software from the national NRCS deployment - Autodesk Civil 3D 2020 (CRQ 3708606).
2. **User:** Verifies that the national NRCS C3D 2020 Customization files have been installed.
 - 2 options can be used for determining if it has been installed:
 - If C:\Program Data\CAD Std 2020 exists and contains 4 folders, then the Customization files have been installed
 - Using *Microsoft Endpoint Manager - Software Center* go to the Applications tab and see whether *NRCS Autodesk Civil 3D 2020 Customization 1.0* shows up. If not, check the Installation Status tab. If it appears there you may be able to force it to complete the installation.
 - If the Customization files are not there 2 days after Civil 3D 2020 is installed, then contact IT to assist with installing *NRCS Autodesk Civil 3D 2020 Customization 1.0* (CRQ 3745097).
3. **User:** Follows instructions for setup of NRCS customization ([User setup NRCS Civil 3D 20.pdf](#))
